


1. In accordance with national administrative review regulations, appeal against the decision of detention could be made to the related regional MSA offices (totally 14), which cover certain port offices which deliver the notice of the detention, within 60 days from the date of detention. The regional MSA office, taking the responsibility of supervising the quality of PSC inspections, will examine and make decision on the appeal within 60 days from the date of acceptance of the appeal.

In the case of the appeal-maker does not accept the decision made by the regional MSA office, it might forward the appeal to the head office for reviewing again.

The appeal might also be forwarded to the head office of China MSA directly. Generally, however, the appeal will be transferred to the regional MSA in charge for initial reviewing before the head office returning its decision to the qualified appeal-maker.

2. In the case of the party concerned disagreed with the decision of the administrative review, the appeal may be brought to a People's Court in accordance with the national laws.



When a ship in Hong Kong waters is detained by Marine Department Port State Control Officer(s) on the ground that the ship is unsafe to proceed to sea and/or fails to comply with the applicable international convention requirement(s), the master or owner of the ship may, if believing that the ship has been unduly detained, request the Marine Department to review the detention.</li><li>2. Request for review of detention shall be made in writing within thirty (30) days from the date the notification of detention is served, either by post, facsimile or email to:</li></ol>



.2 The shipowner, ISM operator, or flag State may request a detention to be reviewed by submitting such request along with a statement and supporting documentation of the reasons why the owner, operator, or flag State believe that the vessel has been or was detained in error. #### **Other relevant information**

The procedures are regulated in: - Legislative Decree No. 1147 - Regulations of Legislative Decree No. 1147 - Directorial Resolution No. 460 - 2023 that regulates the procedures and provisions on Port State Control. The National Maritime Authority has the power to enforce the procedures on port state control established by the International Maritime Organization and its relevant instruments. The captain, company or its representative of the ship has the obligation to comply with what is ordered by the National Maritime Authority with respect to the detention order.

The appeal will not lead to the suspension of detention. Likewise, the captain or his representative will report on the correction of the deficiency, subsequently the PSCO will carry out the verification of the report on correction of the deficiency, which will duly inform the captain or representative of the ship about the result of the follow-up inspection at his discretion. Once the result will be sent to the

Directorate of inspections, audits and port state control so that it can inform the flag state, consul, RO, etc. about the situation of the vessel.

1. As a procedure, the National Port State Control Service- Philippines deals with detention appeals/ complaints from the flag State or Recognized Organization.
2. In such cases, the National Port State Control Service – Philippines will set up a “Detention Review Panel” comprising of 3 Senior Port State Control Officers (PSCOs). The NPSC Secretariat, will inform the concerned PSC Center and Division for the review to submit relevant information. The Panel will proceed with the review, based on the information submitted by the flag State and/or the Recognized Organization, and the concerned PSC Center or Division.
3. The National Port State Control Service – Philippines through the Detention Review Panel should investigate and recommend to the Director, National Port State Control Service of the result of the investigation for his endorsement to the Commander, Maritime Safety Services Command and the approval of the Commandant, Philippine Coast Guard.

4. The National Port State Control Service – Philippines shall inform the flag State or the Recognized Organization of the outcome. If the National Port State Control Service – Philippines agrees to reverse its decision it should also inform the Secretariat and the APCIS Manager.
5. If the flag State or the Recognized Organization disagrees with the outcome, or a port State's outcome has not been received within reasonable time, a request for review may be sent to the Tokyo MOU Secretariat for proper disposition.

Appeal process for detention orders
<p>The concerned parties shall appeal against the detention order to PSCO who issued the detention order within fifteen days from the date of detention. The appeal must be made in writing, with specifying arguments and facts or legal references. However the appeal does not prevent the enforcement of the detention order. The PSCO shall consider the appeal and notify the appellant without delay but not more than thirty days from the date of receiving the appeal. In the case of agreeing to the appeal, whether in whole or in part, the detention order shall be changed without delay. If the PSCO do not agree with the appeal, whether in whole or in part, they should rapidly report with the reason to his Director** in the hierarchy. The Director shall complete its consideration of the appeal within thirty days from the date of receiving the report. If there is a necessity, it cannot be considered within the said period. The Director shall notify the appellant in writing before the expiration of the period. Therefore, the duration for the appeal can be extended for thirty days the results of scrutiny make by the Director are considered.</p>

\*\*Director means the Director of the responsible area. For PSCO in Marine Department has 2

major responsible areas that is:

1. Head office (Bangkok area), the Director shall be the Director of Ship Standard Bureau.
2. Branch office (the area other than Bangkok), the Director shall be the Director of the branch office, whom the non-dedicated PSCO work with.

1. The appeal against the detention order shall be made in writing by the Owner or Master of the concerned vessel within 90 days from the date of detention. It shall be submitted to the Director of the concerned Local Maritime Administration.
2. Within 15 days upon receipt of the claim, the Director of the concerned Local Maritime Administration has to notify the claimant of whether or not the claim shall be processed. If not, reasons need to be clarified.
3. The claim should be settled not later than 30 days or 45 days in case of complications from the date of its receipt.
4. In case of dissatisfaction with the settlement by the Director of Local Maritime Administration or if no settlement is carried out by them, the concerned parties should bring the matter to the Administrator of Vietnam Maritime Administration (Fax: +84-24-37683058; e-mail: <a href="mailto:safetydept@vinamarine.gov.vn">safetydept@vinamarine.gov.vn</a> ). The VINAMARINE will settle the matter not later than 60 days.
